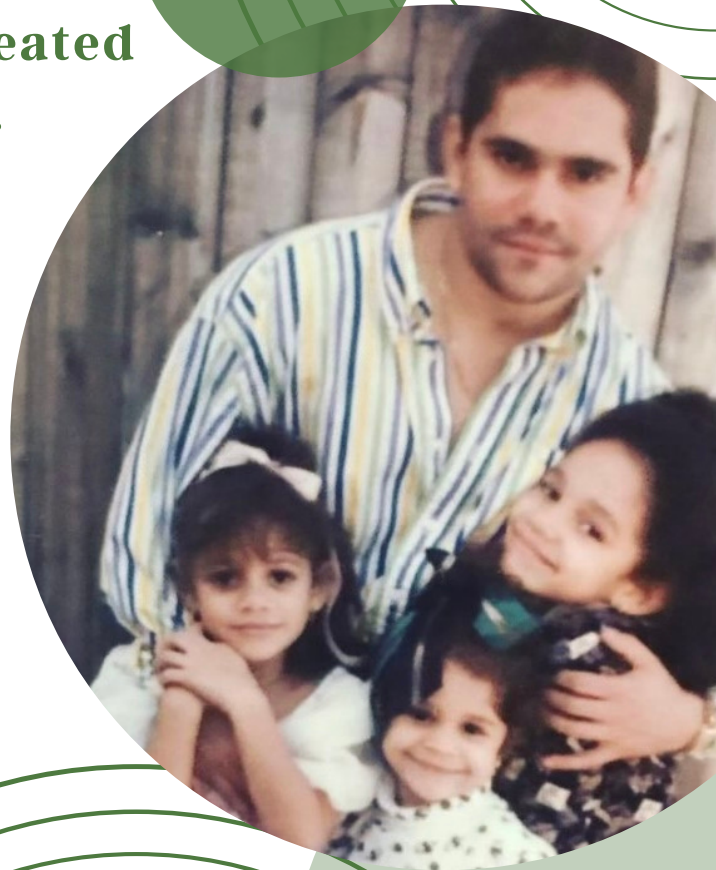

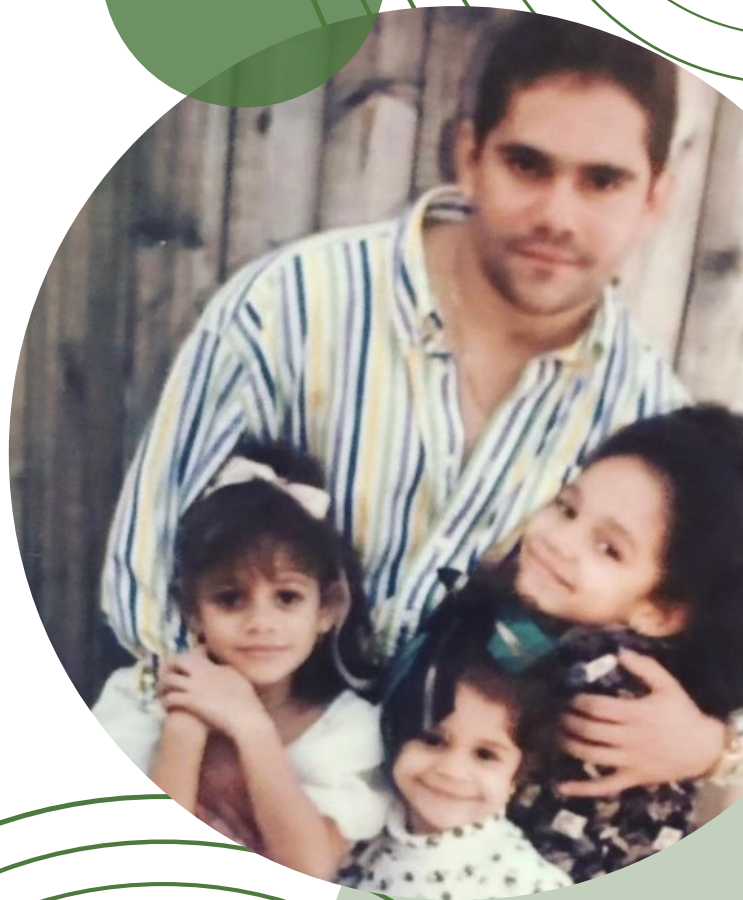
- **New York or New Jersey Resident**
